EPA Renovation, Repair and Painting Program

The RRP Rule affects contractors, property managers and others who disturb lead-based paint during renovation. The RRP Rule requires that firms paid to perform renovation, repair, demolition or painting work in pre-1978 housing and child-occupied facilities have their firm certified by EPA. Additionally, the Minnesota Legislature passed a law that is intended to work in conjunction with Federal lead law(s). Essentially, the law requires local municipal building departments to be part of this Federal mandate by requiring each municipal building department to verify contractor compliance with Federally mandated lead certification requirements at the time of permitting. Local building departments are not responsible for any additional type of enforcement of the law; but simply to verify firm certification compliance. **See reverse side for requirements for demolishing buildings and backfilling**

Requirements for Demolishing Buildings and Backfilling Excavations

1. Permit must be secured by licensed contractor; check with building department.
2. Check with all utilities companies and contact Gopher One for utility locates (Dial 811).
3. Contractor must meet all state and local erosion control requirements at all times.
4. All debris must be hauled to a landfill and none left on site.
5. The foundation must be removed below finish grade and hauled out. None can be left in the excavation.
6. The entire basement floor must be removed.
7. All water services need to be shut off at the water main and inspected by Brainerd Public Utilities or City of Brainerd personal unless approval is granted to shut off at the curb stop (new streets only).
8. Sanitary sewer must be mechanically capped at the property line and inspected by the building department or engineering department personnel.
9. Septic systems must be pumped and removed. Pumping must be done by a licensed pumping service, and a copy of the receipt must be provided at the time of inspection.
10. Excavations must be filled to above normal grade (to allow for settling) with good clean fill and covered with at least three (3) inches of topsoil. Site must be seeded and mulched or sodded.
11. All underground tanks must be removed.
