The 2022 elections are fast approaching, and we are in the process of determining who is interested in serving as election judges for the City of Brainerd. The Primary Election will be held on August 9th and the General Election will be held on November 8th. We hope you will consider serving in this important position.

- In order to serve as an election judge, you ***must*** complete a 2-hour training session taking place the week of June 23-30. Additional technology training may be assigned to you for different precinct positions.
- We are hopeful that we will have enough judges that we will be able to schedule judges in shifts and may allow for more people to be able to serve as election judges due to shorter days. Ward 4 polling location will have 2 different ballots since we are combining the precincts to one location again for this election.
